

Where did Jesus teach?




Maps of Jesus' travels




Parables - Jesus would teach by telling stories or using objects to explain things in easily understandable "word pictures'.

Parable of the weeds – Matthew 13

The Parable of the Weeds

²⁴ Jesus told them another parable: "The kingdom of heaven is like a man who sowed good seed in his field. ²⁵ But while everyone was sleeping, his enemy came and sowed weeds among the wheat, and went away. ²⁶ When the wheat sprouted and formed heads, then the weeds also appeared. ²⁷ "The owner's servants came to him and said, 'Sir, didn't you sow good seed in your field? Where then did the weeds come from?'

²⁸ "An enemy did this,' he replied.

Parable of the weeds – Matthew 13

- "The servants asked him, 'Do you want us to go and pull them up?'
- ²⁹ "'No,' he answered, 'because while you are pulling the weeds, you may uproot the wheat with them. ³⁰ Let both grow together until the harvest. At that time I will tell the harvesters: First collect the weeds and tie them in bundles to be burned; then gather the wheat and bring it into my barn."

Parable of the weeds explained

• 1) Who sowed the good seed?

2) Who sowed the weeds?

3) Who do you think the harvesters are?

^{4°} "As the weeds are pulled up and burned in the fire, so it will be at the end of the age. ⁴ The Son of Man will send out his angels, and they will weed out of his kingdom everything that causes sin and all who do evil.

The Lost Sheep – Luke 15

³ Then Jesus told them this parable: 4 "Suppose one of you has a hundred sheep and loses one of them. Doesn't he leave the ninety-nine in the open country and go after the lost sheep until he finds it? ⁵ And when he finds it, he joyfully puts it on his shoulders ⁶ and goes home. Then he calls his friends and neighbors together and says, 'Rejoice with me; I have found my lost sheep.'

⁷I tell you that in the same way there will be more rejoicing in heaven over one sinner who repents than over ninety-nine righteous persons who do not need to repent.

The mustard seed – Matthew 13

³² He told them another parable: "The kingdom of heaven is like a mustard seed, which a man took and planted in his field. ³² Though it is the smallest of all seeds, yet when it grows, it is the largest of garden plants and becomes a tree, so that the birds come and perch in its branches."
