# Supper or Dinner?

Supper

vs

Dinner

- 
- A **light meal** served late evening
  - Informal
  - At home
  - Evening meal only when "dinner" is taken at midday

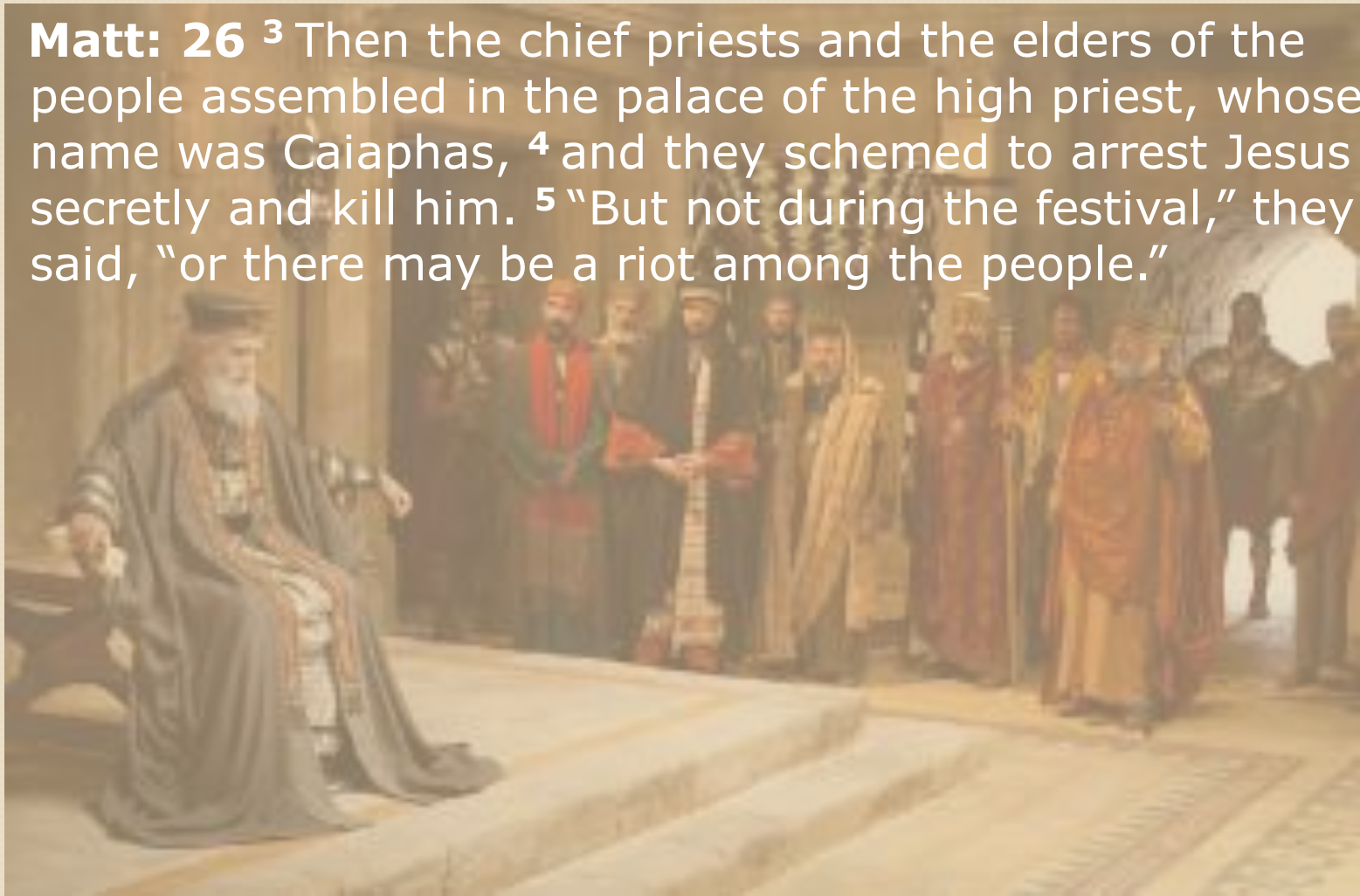
- 
- **Main meal**, usually in the evening
  - Can be more formal
  - At home or at a restaurant
  - Universally used term for evening meals

# Jesus is in Jerusalem

- Passover is being celebrated in Jerusalem.
- There is a lot going on in a short time in Jerusalem. (Matthew 21 – 25)
  - Jesus comes in and clears the temple of people doing business (making money off others).
  - Jesus preaches at the temple during the day and prays on the Mount of Olives at night.
  - Jesus rebukes the Pharisees on several occasions.

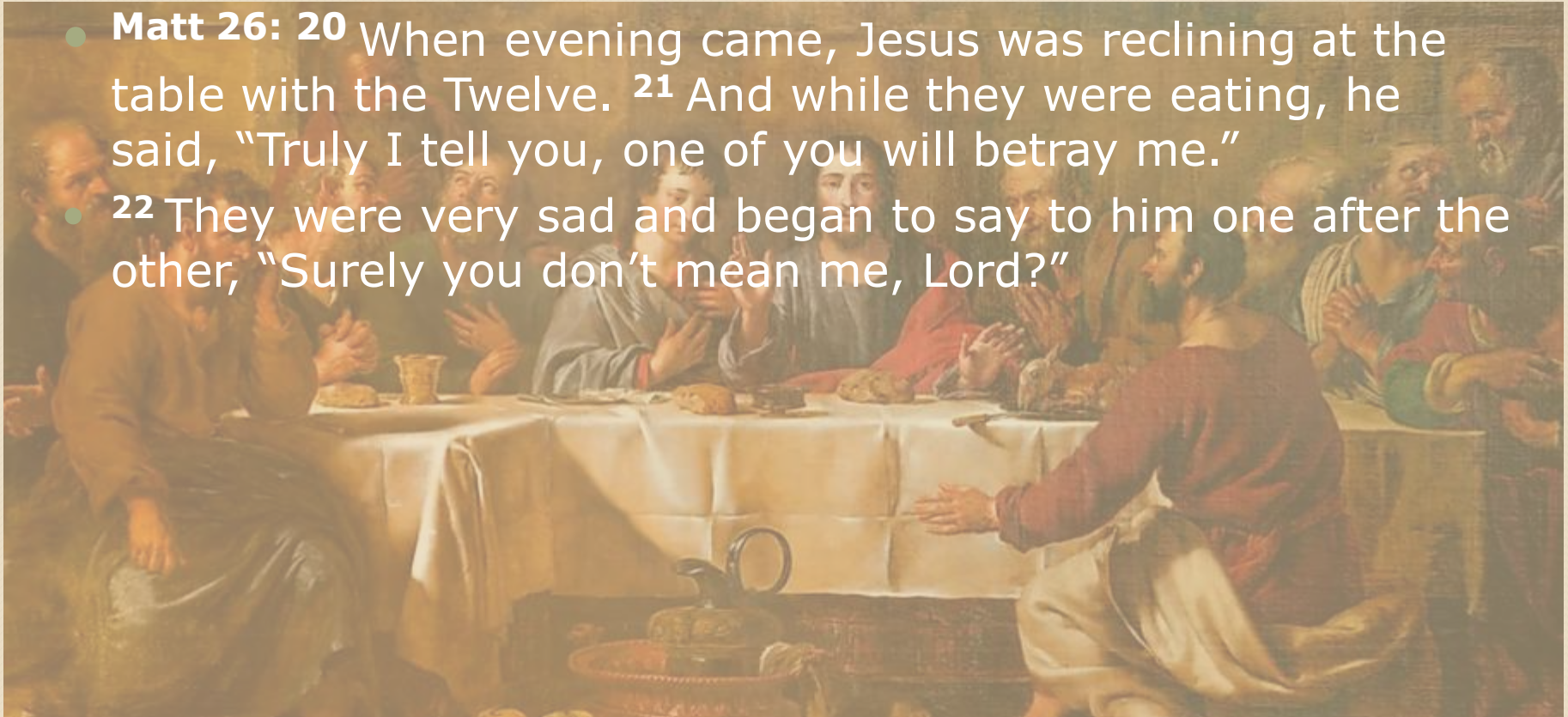
# The Plot Against Jesus

**Matt: 26** <sup>3</sup> Then the chief priests and the elders of the people assembled in the palace of the high priest, whose name was Caiaphas, <sup>4</sup> and they schemed to arrest Jesus secretly and kill him. <sup>5</sup> “But not during the festival,” they said, “or there may be a riot among the people.”



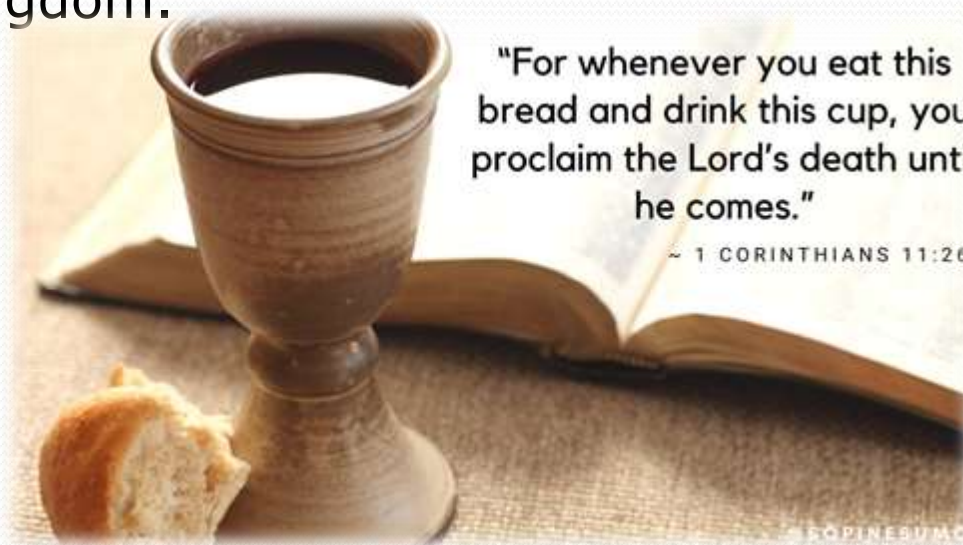
# Supper Conversation

- **Matt 26: 20** When evening came, Jesus was reclining at the table with the Twelve. <sup>21</sup> And while they were eating, he said, "Truly I tell you, one of you will betray me."
- <sup>22</sup> They were very sad and began to say to him one after the other, "Surely you don't mean me, Lord?"



# Supper Conversation

- **Matt 26: 27** Then he took a cup, and when he had given thanks, he gave it to them, saying, "Drink from it, all of you. **28** This is my blood of the<sup>[b]</sup> covenant, which is poured out for many for the forgiveness of sins. **29** I tell you, I will not drink from this fruit of the vine from now on until that day when I drink it new with you in my Father's kingdom."



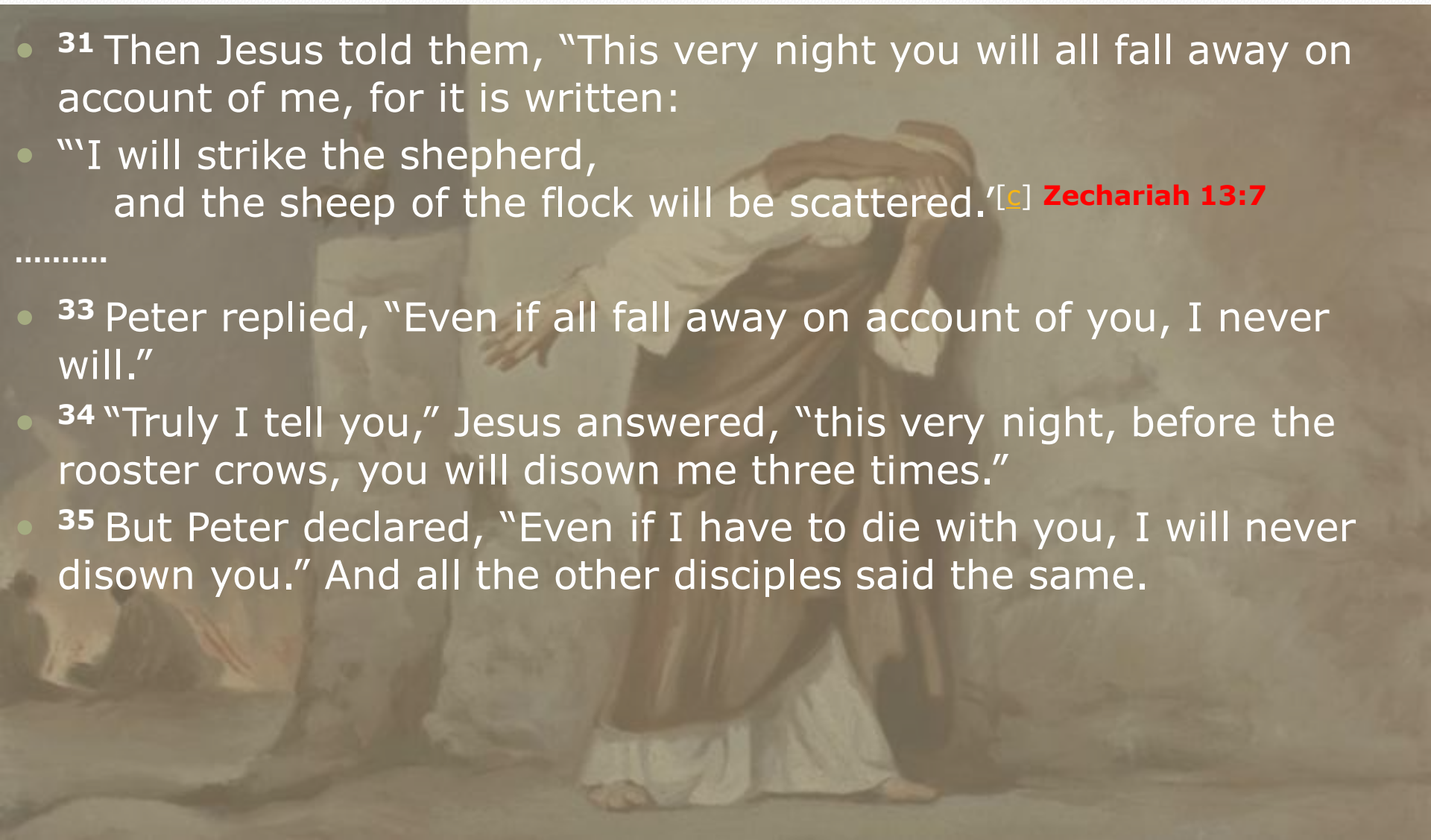
- **30** When they had sung a hymn, they went out to the Mount of Olives

# Jesus Predicts Peter's Denial

- **31** Then Jesus told them, "This very night you will all fall away on account of me, for it is written:
- "I will strike the shepherd, and the sheep of the flock will be scattered." [c] **Zechariah 13:7**

.....

- **33** Peter replied, "Even if all fall away on account of you, I never will."
- **34** "Truly I tell you," Jesus answered, "this very night, before the rooster crows, you will disown me three times."
- **35** But Peter declared, "Even if I have to die with you, I will never disown you." And all the other disciples said the same.
