Background



- Paul described both Timothy and Titus as his sons in the Faith.
- **1&2 Timothy** was written by Paul to Timothy as instructions on how to deal with bad teaching and sins that were occurring in the church at Ephesus.
- **Titus** was written by Paul to Titus for the same reason regarding the church in Crete.

Titus 1 : 10 For there are many rebellious people, full of meaningless talk and deception,**11** they are disrupting whole households by teaching things they ought not to teach—and that for the sake of dishonest gain. **12** One of Crete's own prophets has said it: "Cretans are always liars, evil brutes, lazy gluttons."

Where is Crete?



Titus traveled to Jerusalem with Paul to attend the Jerusalem council (Acts 15). He accompanied Paul on his 3rd Missionary journey as well, during which time Paul sent him to Crete to take care of issues that were arising in the church.

Remember - churches are led by people, who also have flaws. Sometimes we need others to point out where we are wrong!

Rules, Rules, Rules

Some people focus so much on rules and laws that “what they do on the **outside**” is celebrated more than “what is on the inside, in their **hearts**”.

Dealing with sin



Dealing with sin in the church and in our own lives is kind of like how someone deals with weeds in the yard.

First, ***sin*** is anything that we do against the will of God. A simple question to ask ourselves is "what would God want me to do right now".

Like the weeds to the left:

- Some choose not to deal with them.
- Some ignore them until the weeds have taken over.

Do you notice anything about where weeds grow in a yard most often?

- They usually grow where the good grass is thinner...

Dealing with sin

So how do we get rid of weeds and get our grass to look healthy again?

- We can pick the weeds out one by one. Sometimes this is needed.
- We can feed the good grass so that it is too thick and healthy for weeds to grow!

How is this like dealing with sin in our lives?

What should we do to get rid of sin in our own lives?

- We need to repent and ask God for forgiveness.
- We need to ask for forgiveness if we hurt someone else.
- We need to tell someone or confess our sin to someone who is a believer in Christ.
- We need avoid things that cause us to sin.
- We need to fill our yards, I mean lives, with good stuff that God approves of.
